The Department of Operations and Support (DOS) is an organizational part of the Military Leadership Training Institute. Based on the allied and national defense doctrines and on continuous research activity the DOS is responsible for the process of training cadets and officers to carry out their tasks in general and special fields of *military intelligence, field artillery, air defense artillery, military and combat engineering, military geography and mapping, land navigation, and CBRN defense*. The DOS has 6 special subgroups presently to manage these distinct tasks.

The educational activities on the DOS are carried out at three different levels (BA, MA, PhD), and in several special courses.

There around a hundred cadets take part in the specialization and hundreds of other students in different educational programs of the NUPS during every academic year.

Similarly to the educational efforts the DOS has a wide range of scientific activities representing all the disciplines that were involved in providing implementation of above mentioned tasks. The main scientific-research areas are in accordance with the training specializations showing significant results in the related fields as combat simulation systems (TOPCIS), military engineering, security geography, CBRN defense, environmental security, security technology, application and maintaining air defense artillery command and control systems.

Other activities of the DOS:

- Participation on local and international scientific conferences.
- Leadership of research areas in PhD education.
- Producing different educational materials like books, presentations, computer programs and training equipment.
- Supporting activities in scientific students' associations.
- Scientific publication activities and maintenance of professional periodicals.
